ESCHM 2016 GENERAL ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Only abstracts in English and submitted via the online submission system will be accepted for evaluation.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- We suggest that authors create the abstract text externally in Word or similar software before copying into the abstract submission platform.
- After creating your abstract submission account, the abstract submitter (author) will be able to enter the submission platform to insert, edit and submit the final version of the abstract. Please be aware that if you do not "save and submit", your abstract will not be evaluated by the Scientific Committee.
- Authors are expected to choose Free Communication (oral presentation or poster presentation) or Symposium.

Please note that only authors invited by the Organiser are allowed to submit an abstract for a Symposium.

- Authors invited to submit an abstract for a Symposium are requested to select the Symposium to which the abstract should be submitted.
- Authors are expected to submit their abstract under the most appropriate topic. Please select only ONE topic. Authors are not allowed to submit the same abstract for more than one topic.

- Authors are requested to indicate their preference of presentation type (oral presentation or poster presentation). Please note that the scientific committee will make the final decision on the presentation type of accepted abstracts.
- Authors are requested to submit their abstract by indicating the AIM, METHODS, RESULTS and CONCLUSIONS.
- Please note that once the author has submitted the final version of the abstract in the system, it is not possible to undertake any further alterations to the abstract text submitted.

- Presenting authors who are not registered by **30 April 2016** will automatically be removed from the scientific programme.
- Authors who wish to withdraw their abstract from the scientific programme are requested to notify the Abstract submission helpdesk via e-mail: eschm2016@leading.pt.

ABSTRACT TITLE

• The space available for the title of the abstract is limited to 150 characters including spaces.

ABSTRACT BODY TEXT

• The abstract text is limited to a maximum of 1500 characters including spaces.

Tables, figures, references and acknowledgements will count as text and are included in the maximum number of 1500 characters.

IMAGES

• Structural formulae, equations, schemes and figures should be uploaded as single image. In the published abstract the image will appear below the body text and before any references /acknowledgements. In order to be correctly accepted by the system the image should be of jpeg type with a resolution of 300dpi and formatted at maximum 15cmx5cm frame. The maximum size of image accepted is 5 MB. Please note that an image counts as 500 characters.

REFERENCES

• References should be listed sequentially in the end of the abstract text using numbers in square brackets. The author's names are followed by (in *italics*) the name of the journal, the year, volume and the initial page number.
